



THE INGLEWOOD PROJECT (1987)

Wyatt's 4-part mural juxtaposes the face of a Native Californian onto a southwestern landscape. Adobe construction, sandstone walls are juxtaposed with modern concrete buildings similar in aesthetic to the adjacent Civic Center.

Richard Wyatt studied at the Otis Art Institute and the University of California Los Angeles. He created his first mural at age 12 at a sidewalk art contest. Wyatt often weaves cultural history into his murals. He is one of LA's most noted muralists. His monumental work is located throughout Los Angeles including in the Watts Towers, Capitol Records in Hollywood, White Memorial Hospital, Ontario Airport, the Metro Stop at Wilshire and Western, and the East Portal in Union Station.
