This mural was created with Youth Pledging Peace to commemorate Inglewood's designation as an All American City. Artist Michael Massenburg and the local youth wanted to come up with symbols and themes to honor the city of Inglewood.

The artwork centers around the city's seal, and includes painting of other Inglewood landmarks: part of the Forum and Randy's Donuts sign are recognizable to people of the City of Inglewood and to visitors.
